BEARING THE SIGNATURE, (ARTIST OR MAKER)

Although the work is apparently signed by the named artist, no claim to authenticity is implied.

STYLE OF (ARTIST OR MAKER); MANNER OF (ARTIST OR MAKER); or AFTER (ARTIST OR MAKER)

Any of these categories indicate that the work resembles the named artist, may bear their signature, but in our best judgement is not by the named artist. In the case of prints, etchings, or engravings the work may be a restrike dating from after the artist's lifetime.
